## **UVa Miller Center Awards David and Linda Gibson Elizabeth Scott Award for Exemplary Leadership**

The University of Virginia's Miller Center has awarded Mr. David E. and Mrs. Linda J. Gibson the 2012 Elizabeth Scott Award for Exemplary Leadership. The Scott Award recognizes and thanks extraordinary individuals who have given of themselves over time to the Miller Center, U.Va, and the local community.

"David's dedication to the Miller Center is unquestioned. He has ably served in various leadership roles, most notably as co-chair of the Center's Capital Campaign and as a member of the Audit Committee. Prior to my arrival in 2006, David served on a leadership transition team that ran the Miller Center efficiently and effectively for over a year. Having this varied level of exposure, David is in rarefied air in terms of his ability to offer perspective and insight on nearly every aspect of the Miller Center and the Miller Center Foundation," said Gov.
