## **UVa Miller Center Announces Three New Governing Council Members**

The University of Virginia's Miller Center has announced that three new members – Norwood H. Davis, Jr. of Richmond, Va.; H. Eugene Lockhart of Keswick, Va.; and Suzanne S. Whitmore of Sherwood, Md. – will join its Governing Council, which exercises oversight of the Center's work and mission, effective July 1.

"We're delighted to welcome our new members to the Governing Council," said Gerald L. Baliles, director and CEO of the Miller Center. "They bring added intellectual firepower, financial savvy and a strong commitment to the Miller Center's focus on presidential studies, political history and policy issues of importance to the governance of our country."

Norwood H. Davis, Jr. is a senior managing director and advisor at JPB Capital Partners and a senior managing director at JPB Capital Partners II, L.P. He is also a private equity investor in numerous industries, including healthcare, technology, banking, and real estate. Davis served as the chairman and CEO of Anthem Southeast, Inc. (also known as Trigon Healthcare, Inc.). He served as CEO of Trigon from 1981 to 1999, chairman from 1981 to 2001, and chairman emeritus from 2001 to 2002. Davis joined Trigon's predecessor, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Virginia, as house counsel in 1968 and was elected chairman and CEO in 1981, a position he held until his retirement in 2000. Davis earned a JD from the University of Virginia in 1966 and a BS from Hampden-Sydney College in 1963.

H. Eugene Lockhart is an operating partner and chairman of Financial Institutions Investments at Diamond Castle Holdings, LLC. He serves as a senior adviser of Berenson & Company, Inc. Lockhart joined Berenson in 2005 and has more than 25 years of senior-level operating experience at businesses in a variety of industry sub-segments and has also been a venture capital investor specializing in financial services investments. He was a venture partner of Oak Investment Partners, focusing on financial services technology opportunities. Lockhart holds an MBA from U.Va.'s Darden School of Business and a BS from U.Va.

Suzanne S. Whitmore serves on the Hollins University Board of Trustees, where she was board chair from 2010 to 2012. She is also a regent at the George Washington Foundation in Fredericksburg, Va., which includes historic Kenmore as well as George Washington's Ferry Farm. Whitmore's previous board activities include the Academy Art Museum, the Nature Conservancy,

Washington and Jefferson College, The Girl Scout Council of Greater New York, and the Greenwich Library. Whitmore holds a BA in Political Science from Hollins.
