How big a role should the American government play? Should it be shelling out billions for public works and other projects? Is such government involvement unprecedented? Many historians assume the US government of the 19th Century to be hands-off; quintessentially laissez faire. Politicians and analysts who champion such a style of government even regard it as a sort of golden age.

In **A GOVERNMENT OUT OF SIGHT**, (Cambridge University Press; May 21), **Brian Balogh** deconstructs this view, demonstrating that in the 19th Century, even those who argued for a small, nonintrusive central government demanded that the national government expand its authority to meet the nation's challenges. Balogh identifies government programs and subsidies from the 19th Century that survive even today, revising our understanding of the ways in which Americans turned to the national government throughout this period.

A GOVERNMENT OUT OF SIGHT fundamentally alters our perspective on American political development in the 20th Century, shedding light on contemporary debates between progressives and conservatives about the proper size of government and government programs.

Brian Balogh is co-host of the nationally-syndicated radio show *BackStory with the American History Guys*, Chair of the Governing America in a Global Era program at the University of Virginia, and co-Director of the Miller Center Fellowships in Public Affairs.
